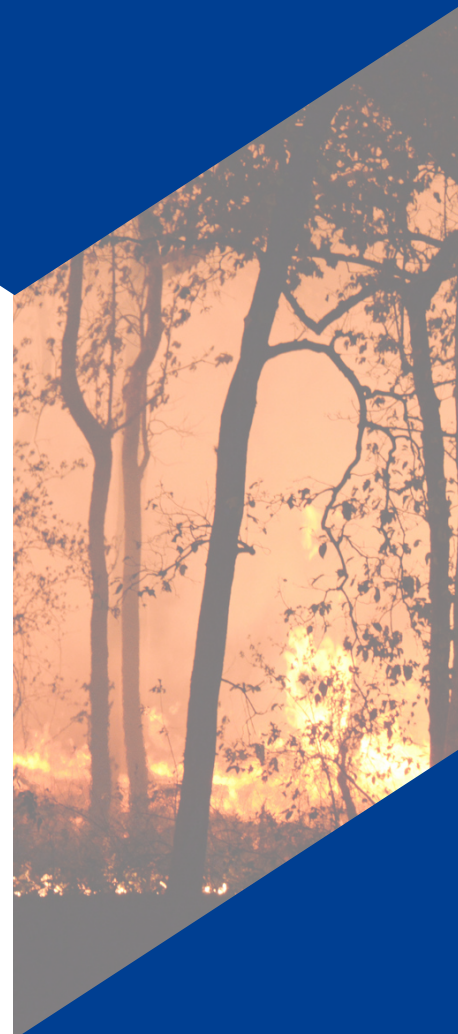
ROUND TABLE: DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Emergencies are not only a security problem, but also an economic and sociological problem.

Depending on the type and severity of the emergency, the consequences for society often do not disappear with the cessation of that danger, but it takes a long time for them to be removed and for the society to recover. Their removal requires broader social action.

The main goal of the round table is to analyze the problems that the population, institutions and competent authorities face during emergency situations. In this way, significant insights are gained into the reactions of the state, society, sociological problems that are emerging, as well as the steps that are being taken to prevent and reduce the consequences of emergencies, as well as new proposals.

In addition, the state of the protection and rescue system, prepared planning documents, civil protection, perspectives of this system, etc. will be discussed.

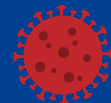
